Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Local Offer

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| Support for children and young people with SEN and disabilities | The Jungle Hut's deputy manager is the SENCO (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator) along with two deputy SENCO's, staff have attended training in; introduction to PEIC-D (Promoting Early Interactive Conversation). All staff regularly attend training to maintain their knowledge. We have access to a range of specialist services to support children with SEND these include Portage, Health Visitors, Speech & Language Therapist, occupational therapist, Educational Psychologists and our Early Years Advisor. Parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's development and educational plans, we have an open-door policy here at the Jungle Hut, and we welcome all parental support and guidance throughout their child's time with us. We ensure that our inclusive admissions practice ensures equality of access and opportunity. Our building and all outside areas are on one level with wide entrances to all areas, our toilet facilities are designed for easy access for adults and children with disabilities. When your child joins us here at the Jungle hut you will have a key worker who will arrange a home visit to meet you and your child. At the meeting we will discuss with you your |
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child's needs and interests. By doing this we can get an indication of support that can be offered and to set up activities and toys of interest to your child. At the home visit we can arrange a taster visit prior to your child starting, so they can familiarise themselves with the setting, staff and other children attending.
