We have class based teaching assistants in all year groups, who are trained in various interventions to deliver to individuals or groups of children across the school where needed. They are directed by the class teacher and Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator (SENCO). We work closely with many outside agencies (Speech and Language, Behaviour Support, School Health, CAMHS etc) to ensure individual children's needs are met.
