Moors Valley has a mixture of habitats including coniferous forest, deciduous woodland, lakes, ponds, rivers, meadow and heathland which in turn support a huge variety of wildlife. Additional Information Moors Valley Country Park and Forest is open from 8am every day of the year except Christmas Day. Closing time is at 5pm from September to March, at 6pm from April to May (later during Easter holidays) and at 7pm during the school holidays. The Moors Valley Railway is open everyday from Spring Bank Holiday week at the end of May through to early September. For the rest of the year it is open during the school holidays and at weekends only. The opening hours are 10.45am to 4.30pm (5pm during summer-term period). There are 13 disabled parking spaces in the first car park loop, near to the ice cream kiosk. If your vehicle is exempt from road tax due to disability reasons, that vehicle may park for free (please see website for details).

The toilets include a Changing Places standard toilet with tracking hoist system and height adjustable changing bed, an Ambulant Disabled toilet and large family cubicles can be found on the outside of the building.
