

## Sherborne Learning Centre

Sherborne Learning Centre is Local Authority Pupil Referral Unit which makes educational provision for children who, for a variety of reasons, are not able to attend school. Currently there are five learning centres across the county, all registered as schools by the Department for Education. Pupils may have been permanently excluded from school, be at risk of exclusion and dual registered with their mainstream school, be unable to attend school for medical reasons or be experiencing other difficulties which prevent them from attending their school full-time.
