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## Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Local Offer

**Support for children and young people with SEN and disabilities**

Shaftesbury CE Primary School has a graduated response to the children's Special Educational Needs. All children have their own individual learning needs which are addressed through quality whole class teaching and careful differentiation according to prior attainment and learning style. In addition to this we also recognise and address more specific needs with appropriate interventions in and out of the classroom. We cater for children with difficulties in Cognition and Learning, Communication and Interaction, Social Emotional and Mental Health and Sensory or Physical needs. Most of our children who are on register are on the SEN Support stage of the Code of Practice so their needs are fully catered for in school with some input from external services. We also have some children in school with higher levels of need whose needs are met through an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP).
