A child is classed as having special educational needs if he or she has learning difficulties that call for special educational provision to be made. It's catchment are the villages of Burton Bradstock, Shipton Gorge and Chilcombe, but also include children from other areas around Bridport. Children are grouped into four classes covering Reception to Year 6. Children with special educational needs are given additional support, in small groups or individually. It is the policy of the school to encourage and support all pupils to realise their full potential.
