A child is classed as having special educational needs if he or she has learning difficulties that call for special educational provision to be made. Children are grouped into four classes covering Reception to Year 6. Children with special educational needs are given additional support, in small groups or individually. It is the policy of the school to encourage and support all pupils to realise their full potential.
